WHEN

- ♦ Begins Monday, September 21, 2009 and ends Monday, June 14, 2010
- ♦ Credit (high school) classes are held once a week, Mondays only from 6:00 to 9:00 pm (see program on back)
- ♦ General interest classes are held once a week, Mondays only from 6:30 to 8:30 pm. (see program on back)

ELIGIBILITY

- ♦ Adults 18 years of age or older
- ♦ Secondary school students may register if:
 - i) the course is unavailable at student's regular day school;
 - ii) the student obtains written permission from his/her day school principal or designate.

ATTENDANCE

Prompt, daily attendance is expected. Three **absences** will result in withdrawal from the credit course program. Three lates will classify as one absence.

FEE

None for Ontario Secondary school students taking credit courses other than a **\$10 cash consumable fee (non-refundable)**. One payment per person per course. VISA students are required to pay an \$800 fee per course (cash or certified cheque only), payable in full at registration. Refunds only for cancelled courses. A book deposit of **\$75 (cheque only)** is required on the first day of classes for most credit courses. The cheque will be returned when the student returns the book. Please make cheques payable to **St. Charles**.
