Dear Parents and Students

The Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board, through St. Charles Adult and Continuing Education, welcomes you to Grade 9. As a secondary student you will have new and exciting times at high school full of opportunities and experiences to look forward to.

Each of our Catholic Secondary Schools are now preparing for their Grade 9 Summer Orientation Program called, **“Passport to Grade 9”**. This program represents our commitment to provide students with the knowledge and skills to attain success in both their learning and growth in all aspects of life and faith.

The program’s emphasis is on providing a snapshot of the Grade 9 secondary experience by orienting, supporting and meeting the needs of our incoming students. It is taught by fully qualified teachers and focuses on preparing the students for the major differences between their elementary experience and their upcoming secondary school journey.

The **Passport to Grade 9** is a **two-day program** which includes the following:

- The distinctiveness of Catholic Schools and integration of the Ontario Catholic Graduate Expectations;
- The development of Learning Skills and Work Habits;
- Educational Pathways and Career Planning;
- Health and Wellness;
- The values of teamwork and collaboration;
- Orientation to their Secondary School

Your secondary school will conduct a **third day** that showcases their Grade 9 Orientation Day. The secondary school will be notifying you in the coming months of an agenda of their activities for the day.

Each year, high schools host incoming grade 9s on the last week of August with a grade 9 barbecue. The date of the School based grade 9 barbecue is currently not available by secondary school, therefore Passport to grade 9 would be affected as follows:

- * If your school based barbeque is on Monday, then passport to grade 9 will run Tuesday and Wednesday,
- * If your school based barbecue is on Tuesday, then passport to grade 9 will run Monday and Wednesday
- * If your school based barbecue is on Wednesday, then passport to grade 9 will run Monday and Tuesday.
- * **St. Thomas More’s school run Orientation day is on Thursday August 30, 2018**

The **Passport to Grade 9** program is fully interactive, embracing technology by using blended learning and web 2.0 tools. Students will be permitted to bring their own devices to the classroom.
